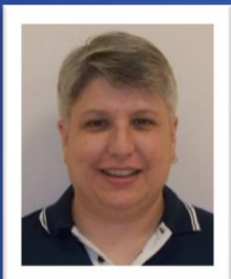
Travis Kramolis, DPT

Judy Jorgensen, OTR/L

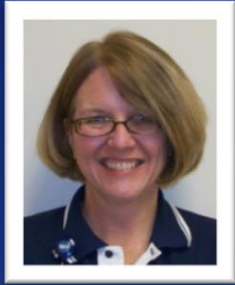
