Flowers Plus volunteers water and care for the plants in the common areas throughout the hospital, clinic and Lake Winona Manor. Flowers Plus volunteers also arrange funeral bouquets brought to the hospital into smaller arrangements and then place them in various areas. Volunteers in this service area also help with campus-wide decorating during the holidays.

Why is this area important?

Flowers provide a touch of nature and comfort, especially appreciated during the winter months when it's more difficult to be outside. The beautiful plants with lush foliage and blooms can transform waiting areas into warm, colorful, cheery, welcoming places.
